

WELCOME BACK!!!



We are thrilled to be able to welcome you back to the church sanctuary so that you can worship in-person again.

In the meantime, as we prepare to return to being present in-person in the church sanctuary, please keep the following in mind in order to ensure we are taking care of our entire faith community to the best of our ability:



- **Entrance:** Please use the main sanctuary doors. We continue to maintain separate entrances for the church and the daycare. The south entrance is for daycare use only.

- **Masks and Hand Sanitizer:** Please wear a mask inside the church and use hand sanitizer when you enter and leave. We do ask you to be gracious and considerate with each other as there are people among us who cannot wear masks for whatever reason. Maintaining physical distancing is also important.

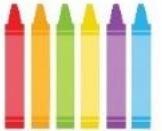


- **Seating:** Please spread yourselves out in the pews to encourage physical but not social distancing. Green check marks are located on the pews to show you where to sit. It may not be the place you think of as your "usual" pew. Sit down anyway and be welcome!



- **Couples and Groups:** People coming in couples or in a family or cohort group should of course sit together.

- **Children and Youth:** For the time being, all members of a family will remain in the sanctuary to participate in worship. Pew boxes with activities will be available.



- **Offering:** During the in-person service, we ask you to leave your offering in an offering plate by the entry to the sanctuary. You can also continue to make your offerings in several ways: E-transfer, PAR, online through Canada Helps, and by cheque sent in or dropped-off at the church.



- **Singing:** Yes, if you are asked to do so during worship. All singers must wear a mask.

- **Communion:** Our first in-person and online communion will be Worldwide Communion Sunday, October 3. Those in-person will be served communion while remaining seated. Those on-line will participate from home.



- **Vaccination:** Ideally you will be double vaccinated as that is the first level of protection for yourself and others. We will not be screening your vaccination status. We ask you to self-screen and remain home if you fall into a Covid exposure or high -risk category for transmission.

We are moving slowly and methodically into our reopening.
